Kia ora Mace

The Tūpuna Maunga Authority has a multi-year vegetation restoration programme underway that includes removing exotic trees and undertaking restoration planting to heal the mauri of the Tūpuna

Maunga and enhance their biodiversity. This programme has been reported to the Governing Body through the Tūpuna Maunga Operational Plan 2018/19 (and Long Term Plan 2018 -2028).

The programme started this year with Maungarei/Mt Wellington.

In 2018/19 we are looking to:

- complete removals on Maungarei/Mt Wellington and continue planting,
- consent and start works on Ōhūiarangi/Pigeon Mountain, Mangere Mountain and Ōtahuhu/Mt Richmond, and
- consent Ōwairaka/Mt Albert, Te Tātua a Riukuita/Big King and Te Kōpuke/Mt St Johns.

Many of the Tūpuna Maunga have contiguous lands owned by Auckland Council held under either the Reserves Act or the Local Government Act. On 22 August 2013, the Auckland Council resolved that decision making in relation to lands contiguous to the Tūpuna Maunga would be allocated to the Governing Body (resolution GB/2013/86). In relation to such contiguous land the Council staff report stated:

“It is anticipated that decision making responsibility for such land would remain with the governing body following formation of the Maunga Authority, although council may decide to transfer decision making responsibility for these areas of land to the Maunga Authority in the future. The management of these areas of land would be integrated as far as possible into the management of the adjacent crown owned land that is subject to Treaty of Waitangi settlement” (Report to Governing Body, 22 August 2013, Item 16, p259; CP2013/15305).

It is anticipated that this matter will be reported up to the Governing Body later this year.

There are also other lands either owned by, or vested in, the Auckland Council which are contiguous to the Tūpuna Maunga, but not included in the 2013 report to the Auckland Council.

We are seeking approval from you, under delegation, to include the contiguous lands allocated to the Governing Body in the Vegetation Restoration Project’s resource consent applications for each maunga. Written approval of this request will form part of the resource consent applications for the relevant maunga.
